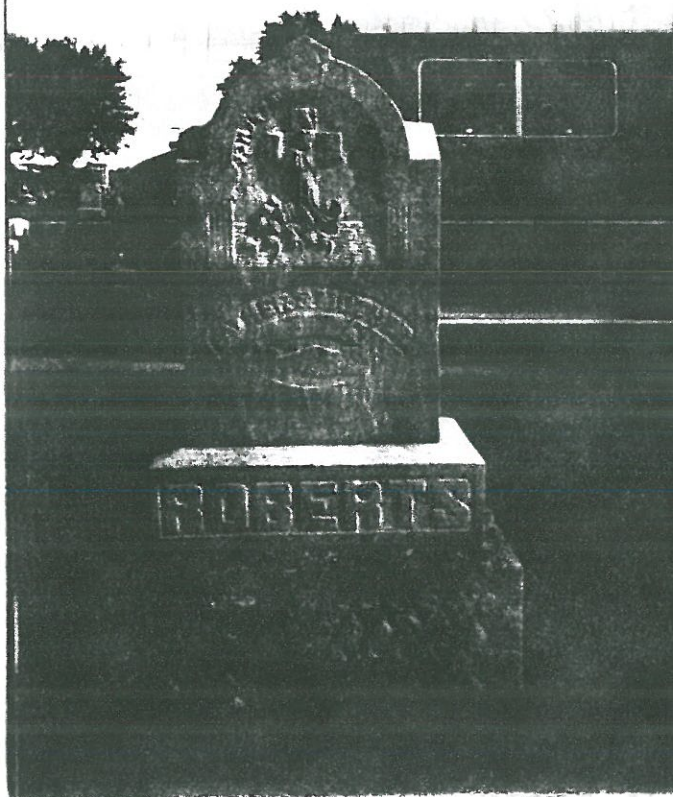

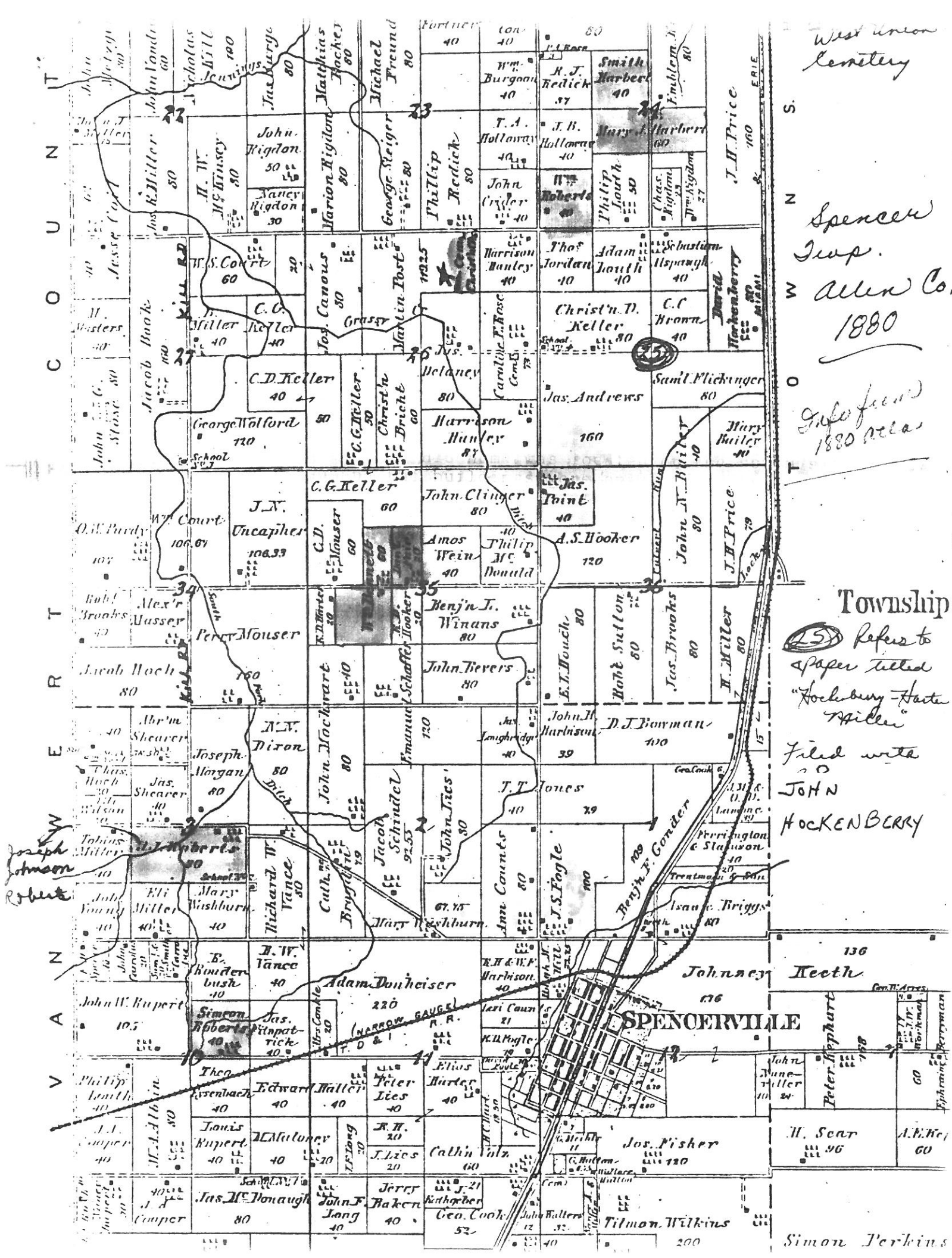

WILLIAM BENNETT - JOSEPH JOHNSON ROBERTS

Information taken from the map of Spencer Twp.. Allen Co. Ohio, 1880. The map legend says that 2 inches equals a mile, so using that as the guide, we started at the West Union Cemetery, where our Great-Grandfather, William Bennett is buried, and according to Pearl Miller (my mother), our Grandmother, Nancy Bennett-Roberts-King is buried there also. She has no tombstone.

From West Union Cemetery, go west $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles to Kill Road. Go south $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to *State Route 81*. There are no road signs at this intersection, that I could find. Turn east and go $\frac{3}{4}$ mile and William Bennett's farm was located here. He owned 60 acres of land and according to the map, he owned land on both sides of the road. His home was located on the south side of *SR 81*. Road and the buildings were on the north side of the road. There is an old barn and corn crib still standing at this location.

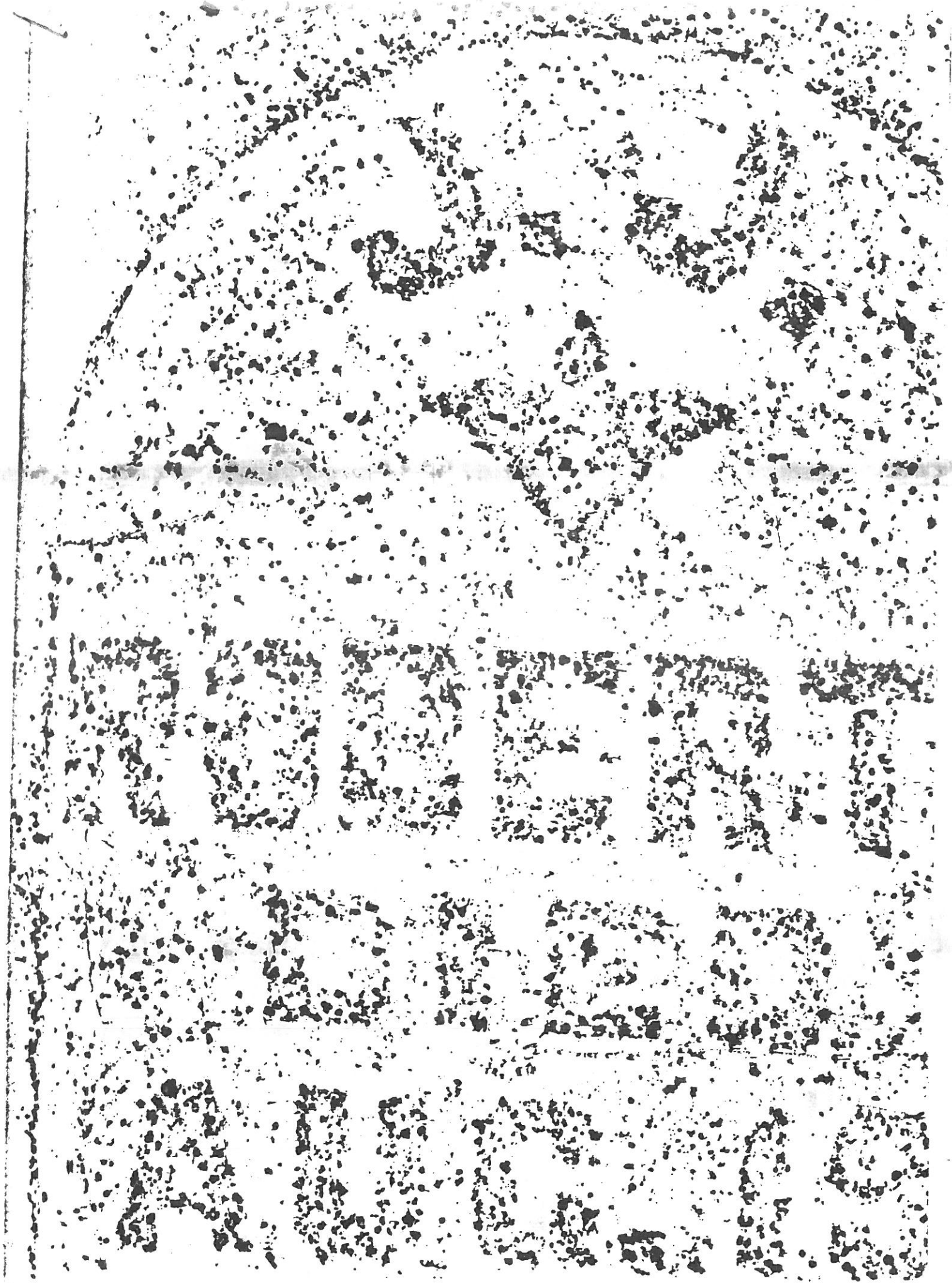
From West Union Cemetery, go west $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles to Kill Road. Then go south $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles. The road dead-ends there, and as you are looking south, this is the land our Great-Grandfather Joseph Johnson Roberts owned. His land consisted of 80 acres. There are no buildings standing today that I could find.

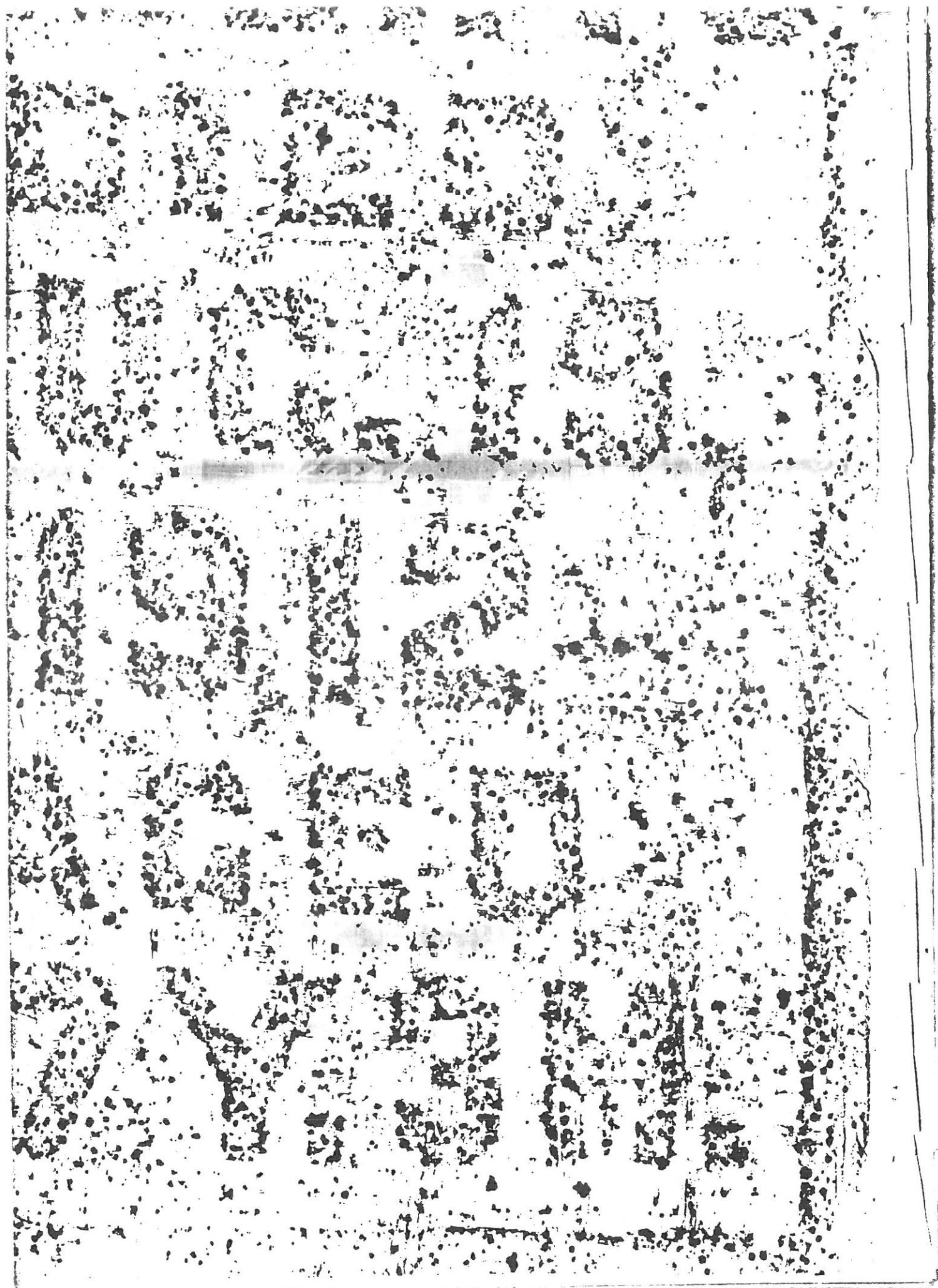
