CHARLES KISSINGER enlisted November 25, 1776 in the Pennsylvania troops and was discharged August 9, 1783, and a warrant numbered 303 for one hundred acres of bounty land, for the above services as a Private, was delivered to him March 30, 1808. There are no further particulars given.

Personally appeared before the subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace in & for said County John Scott, Esq who being duly sworn on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God, doth dispose and say that Charles Kissinger has disposed to him a discharge signed A. B. Batten of the 9th August 1783 enlisted the 25th November 1776 with whom he has been acquainted (?) or about two years, & during which time he always knew him by the name of Charles Kissinger sworn and subscribed this second day of June A.D. 1804.

Also look at the normal way of writing double s's on early documents with a quill pen. The normal way looks like fs. Now look at how Charles signs his name on the Cullodian and on John's indenture papers. You see how distinctive Charles way of making the two s's are.
